**Schnitzer Investment Corp.** (now MMGL Corp.) donates 20 acres of land on Portland's South Waterfront for OHSU's future expansion.

**Anonymous donor** provides initial funding to construct the Collaborative Life Sciences Building featuring a cutting-edge imaging lab for Knight Cancer Institute research.

Gift from **Phil and Penny Knight** establishes the Knight Cancer Institute and enables OHSU to recruit more than 40 new cancer researchers and clinical leaders. Intel and FEI partnerships launch new era of industry collaboration.
