

/ith the devastating loss of federal protections over abortion care, basic health care services have become unsafe and inaccessible to individuals in more than a dozen states, disproportionately affecting low-income people and already marginalized communities. OHSU's stance is unequivocal: abortion care is health care.

In response, OHSU launched a new Center for Reproductive Health Equity to advance reproductive health services, education and policy research, and established the Abortion Care & Training (ACT) Fund to quickly mobilize resources to:

- Expand clinical services within OHSU and meet the patient need
- Train more clinicians to provide abortion care, especially those practicing in states that have banned or restricted this training
- Generate research data that guides the development of evidence-based public policy

Donors heard the call and responded in significant ways, giving more than \$1.3 million in the past year to support reproductive health care initiatives at OHSU. We are grateful for the outpouring of support and are proud to share the following update one year later:
