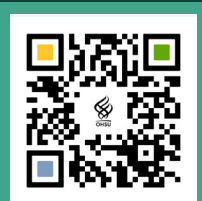
Something to Crow About

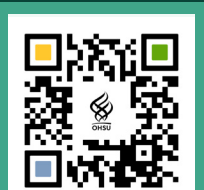

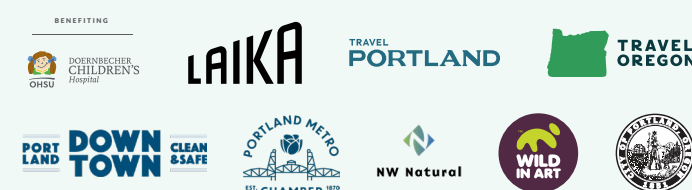
